


Use this guide to understand the proper use of STAT. Remember, emergencies should always be referred to the ER!






STAT Definition

An expedited determination is a situation where the timeframe of the standard decision-making process could seriously jeopardize the life or health of the patient or could jeopardize the patient's ability to regain maximum function.




Review the Guidelines

A review of the clinical guideline may help determine the likelihood of approval and you'll know what information will be required







- The test or procedure is very important -we understand, but that still does not fall under the definition of a STAT request
- Tests ordered prior to consult with a specialist
- The patient would like answers right away
- Provider/scheduler forgot to submit the request
- Internal office staff trying to "finish things up" before a vacation or holiday

Submit these requests as Normal, not STAT
