Here are the key search functions for WebStatus

- Search by HealthHelp reference number (tracking number) or the authorization number issued by the health plan
- 2. Search by Member ID (Exact ID required)
- 3. Search by Member name
- Filter search results for requests made within any 90-day time period by selecting a start and end date
- Filter results by Ordering Provider (applies to WebConsult users)
- Filter results by Rendering Facility (applies to WebStatus users and WebConsult users with facility privileges)

We have added more information to the search results:

- The NEXT STEP area will show you what actions are needed next.
- Even more detail is available under ACTIONS
 - Select VIEW to see the case summary for more detail such as:
 - Procedure Code(s) approved
 - Diagnosis Code
 - Assessment questions answered
 - Facility and appointment information
 - Clinical documents uploaded, date uploaded, file size and who uploaded the file(s).
 - Select **PRINT** to print the approved authorization.
